



Impact Summary June 2012

- The building of a domestic drinking water system for House of Hope orphanage and Beraca Medical Center, which also serves the area. This system prevented the spread of a cholera outbreak in 2011
- The construction of new bathrooms including flush toilets and showers at House of Hope in 2012
- Acquiring, transporting, and providing parts for the only ambulance in this region of 500,000 residents (2003-present)
- The construction of a three-bedroom house to host volunteer teams
- Participation in Over 40 trips between 2003-2013 to House of Hope and Beraca Medical Center for oversight of projects, training of Haitian workers, encouragement to caregivers (doctors, staff, volunteers) as well as time and attention to the children
- Acquiring, transporting, and successfully delivering food and water to House of Hope as well as medical supplies to Beraca Medical Center from 2003-2012

Future Projects Include....

- Construction of a wastewater reclamation facility to purify water for release into surrounding farmlands
